CAPEL-LE-FERNE PARISH COUNCIL – (Some of the items discussed 17th March)

Neighbourhood Watch: Parking of cars and HGV on footpaths and at junctions a cause for concern and being monitored by Community Warden.. Stealing of metal and charity bags being investigated further. School Travel Plan completed and subject to consultation – this will form the basis of certain improvements on routes for children to school and parking etc. Dog warden patrolling to be monitored further – Dog Warden to be invited to attend a Parish Council meeting. Use of off road bikes to be reported to Police.

Highways/Bridleways and Public Rights of Way: Installation of speed limit gates completed. These will be painted white before 1st June. Discussion on the maintenance and responsibility of the gates will take place at future meeting. All items of highway maintenance reported and logged with Kent Highways under new scheme. Very large pothole Victoria Road/B2011 junction reported for repair. Footpath outside school delayed due to further investigation on ownership of land. Manhole cover missing across playing field reported and reinstated. Installation of speed limit indicator at Dover end of village reported to be carried out in April.

Other items: Annual Parish Council certificates. Grounds Maintenance for 2009. Speed cameras in Capel Street. New Bus Shelter.

Next Parish Council meeting is on 21st April 2009 at 7.30pm in the Village Hall (Small Hall). 

From the Vicarage

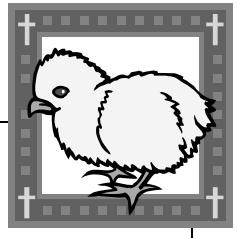
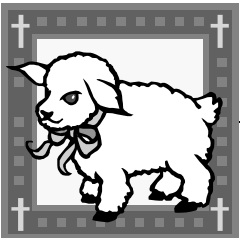

More good news – we are grateful to Brian Cope from Kent County Council who has allocated some of his members' grant money to replace the water boiler in the kitchen. It will have a larger capacity, but ½ hour after being switched on 100 cups can be drawn off at once.

Have you experienced the 'Capel Bang?' It's one side of Capel that many of us do not recognise. An explanation is given in the question below

Can you recognise who or what the following description relates to?

“ XXXX are responsible for the direction and performance of their charity.

If there are few or no staff they may be directly involved in the day-to-day running of the charity. If it is a larger charity staff will usually carry out the work of the charity and the XXXX will be responsible for monitoring and controlling their activities.

It can be a challenging role. If something goes wrong in the charity's work or finances the trustees bear ultimate responsibility - both legal and financial. But it can also be extremely interesting and rewarding, giving you the chance to exercise existing skills and develop new ones.”

Answer – a Trustee.

Capel-le-Ferne has a strong community spirit and we are very lucky to live here. The village is very fortunate with the number of people who volunteer and get involved. Are you one of them? If you're new to the village it's a great way to met people and find out just how many social events there are.

The current Trustees have taken out Trustee indemnity and have achieved a quality mark for good administration, which mitigates any liability – not that any Trustee has yet been sued, let alone taken to court, provided that they obey the law.

So please help the Village Hall the thriving entity it is by volunteering to help. We are aware that more Trustees will resign at the end of this year and we desperately need new blood to ensure the hall continues to operate.

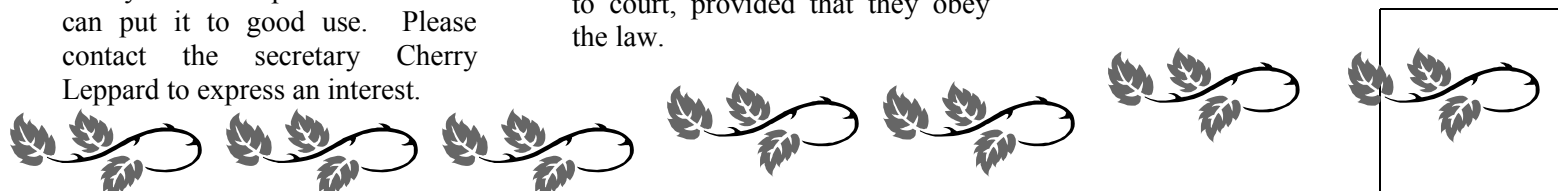
More refurbishment to the hall – work will begin on the ladies toilet then the gents. Derek Jeffrey has worked hard at finding energy efficient solutions – the lights will operate automatically, blade hand driers will be installed. Not only do they dry hands better than conventional driers, they are said to save up to 80% of fuel.

The percussion taps means that the water will turn off automatically. Use of fluffy water – not sure if that is a real technical term – will improve the feel of the water (it's like washing in liquid silk!) reduce the chill of the cold water as well as using less water.

Baby changing facilities are due to be fitted in the disabled toilet, making them accessible to both men and women; we will check that the turning circle for wheel chairs is not impeded.

People are slowly discovering that the Post Office room is in use on Tuesday mornings. Are you one of them?

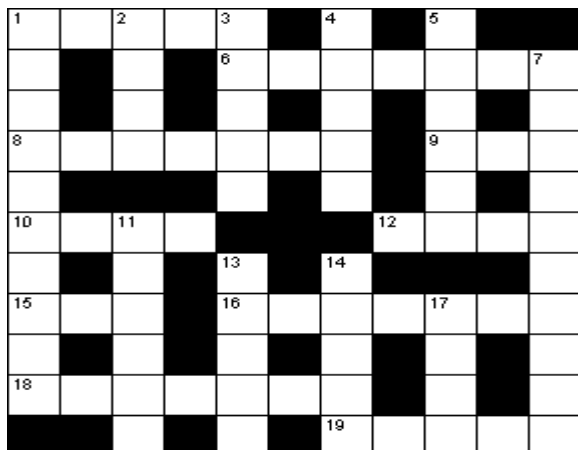
CAPEL-LE-FERNE WI

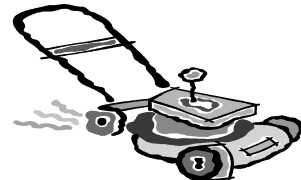


